My name is Arkady Edmunds and i have just sold my older starling and i am in a process of finishing building a new one. I have been quiet successful over the season considering i had a 35 year old boat and an 8 year old sail, and even had some finishes in top 3 on major regattas.

My boat is being built by Tony Van Arn and he also has another one all ready to go. It is brand new with carbon foils and all brand new items. I am sure that it is very well built and with a bit of tuning will go like a rocket. Tony Van Arn was suggested to me as a boat builder by Brian Peet and Francisco Lardies who know what they are saying. Tony built 8 boats so far including mine. One of his boats was sailed by Francisco Lardies in the nationals and only one season of sailing a starling he got a 4th overall, however could easily win the thing. Other examples are Hamish Andrew who was always in the top ten, Ryan Dixon who is usually in the top 8.

The boat number is 1325. It is all set to go. I am quiet sure if you want something changed on the boat before purchase, Tony can do it for you. The price is \$6250 Which is ridiculously cheap for a brand new boat and the reason being not that it is a bad boat but because Tony builds boats more for enjoyment rather than business. Pretty sure this will be a good investment.

- I am emailing you about the family that were looking for a starling. I have a wooden starling that we have owned for around 5 years, I have been racing it for about 2 years as my brother had it before that. Over the 2 years I have been adding bits on and generally upgrading it, and this last season I managed to pick up some reasonable placing's, such as 8th overall in the traveller series, also 1st overall in the Maraitai centreboard regatta 2010. Currently I am

preparing the cockpit to be repainted and will also redo the varnish on the deck. At the last nationals it weighed in at 44kg, but I have done a bit of lightening since then and I am guessing that it will now be around 42-43kg. I think that in the hands of a good sailor it could be a very competitive boat, it should not need any modifications, but if looking to get it in perfect racing condition there are probably a few things that could be done.

- Here is a list of the things I have with it:
- • 2 sails, the best is one season old, still in good condition, the second is a training sail (probably not good for any proper racing).
- • 1 very old training centreboard and one custom built fibreglass centreboard.
- • 3 rudders, 1 is a training rudder (the largest possible dimensions) with carbon reinforcement in the middle, another is a training rudder that could be used for racing as well, the last is a carbon racing rudder.
- • 1 mast new at the end of last year.
- • Some of the ropes have been replaced on the deck as well as a new mainsheet all the other ropes are in good condition, all of the blocks are either harken or ronstan still in good condition.
- • I also built a carbon centreboard that has never been used that can be included at a negotiated price if interested. prwilson@orcon.net.nz
