

# Starling Nationals Entry Declaration

I declare my boat complies with the Starling Class Constitution & Rules dated 1 Jan 2010. In addition I can confirm the following safety and measuring items on my boat are as listed below.

## Measuring

- Measuring Certificate listed in family name of entrant, or if the boat is borrowed, in owner's name.
- Boat weighs minimum 41kg and where necessary, corrector weights are fitted to outside face of cockpit aft bulkhead.
- Mast maximum length 4480mm, including base plug, spacer washers and mounting assembly. (Rule 13.2)
- Three supporting stays attached to mast at 2875 +/- 75mm from the mast base. (Rules 13.5 – 13.9)
- Centreboard maximum length 1067mm. (Rule 12.3)

## Safety

- Bow located towing point fitted for expeditious tow rope attachment. (Conventional lifting handle or loop of 3mm Spectra rope tied through forestay chainplate.)
- Lanyard fitted between centreboard and hull.
- Rudder assembly secured to hull when sailing.
- Hand bailer fitted with securing lanyard.
- Each side of the hull displays Starling insignia and boat numbers permanently marked no less than 50 mm high.
- Skipper's weight within flotation range of their lifejacket.
