NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 Under rule 87, Rule 7 (a) of the class rules is deleted and replaced by: The Laser shall be raced by one person aboard. The crew shall not change during the event.

1.3 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

1.4 No two boats in the same class may use the same sail number

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A for P class and Starling, and Category C for all other classes

2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the P class, Starling, Splash, Laser Radial, 420, 29er, Techno and RSX classes.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Torbay Sailing Club by **March 31st**. Box 35170 Browns Bay

3.3 Late entries will be accepted until April 10.00hrs on the 8th of April together with an additional late entry fee of \$20.

3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

<i>Singlehanded</i>	<i>\$80 or \$60 if entry received before March 31st</i>
<i>Doublehanded</i>	<i>\$100</i>

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

5.2 Dates of racing: 8 April to 10 April

5.3 Number of races:

All classes are scheduled to race 3 races back to back on each day

5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11.00.

On 10th April no warning signal will be made after 16.00 hours.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall be in possession of a valid measurement certificate and may be asked to produce it at any time.

In addition additional measurements may be taken.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on 8 April.

8 VENUE

8.1 The venue is Torbay on North Shore of Auckland

8.2 The location of the racing areas are in the waters off Torbay.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Trapezoid or Windward / leeward.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

11 SCORING

11.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

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LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Torbay beach.

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RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
